SAN DIEGO – (September 12, 2011) — During the recent power outage that swept across the Southwest, StatRad remained fully operational to ensure continuous care. The outage—the largest in the region’s history—left nearly 5 million residents in California, Arizona, and Mexico in the dark for more than 12 hours. In San Diego, gas stations, traffic systems, banking services, and business centers were completely shut down, bringing commerce in the nation’s eighth largest city to a grinding halt.
